**PSPCC Resolution No. 07
Series of 2019**

**APPROVING THE ADOPTION OF THE MODULAR OPEN SOURCE IDENTITY
PLATFORM (MOSIP) AS THE IDENTITY PLATFORM OF PHILSYS**

WHEREAS, the Philippine Identification System (PhilSys) requires a platform which has the following features: (1) configurability and customizability, (2) short time development, (3) low cost and vendor neutrality, (4) origins drawing on international best practices, (5) security and privacy protecting features, and (6) full control and ownership over the platform;

WHEREAS, the Modular Open Source Identity Platform (MOSIP) is a technology platform that helps government and other user organizations implement a digital, foundational identification system;

WHEREAS, after a series of meetings and consultations and upon the conduct of a research study, the Inter-Agency Committee (IAC) on Technology has endorsed the adoption of MOSIP to the PSPCC for approval (Annex CR 07-20190422);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council approves the adoption of the Modular Open Source Identity Platform (MOSIP) as the identity platform of the PhilSys subject to the conduct of market sensitization to determine whether the term MOSIP will be reflected in the bidding and other legal documents;

RESOLVED FINALLY, that the Council authorizes the PSA and DICT, on behalf of the Republic of the Philippines, to negotiate the terms and conditions of the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with International Institute of Information Technology, Bangalore (IIIT-B) or its nominated agency under an open source license.
